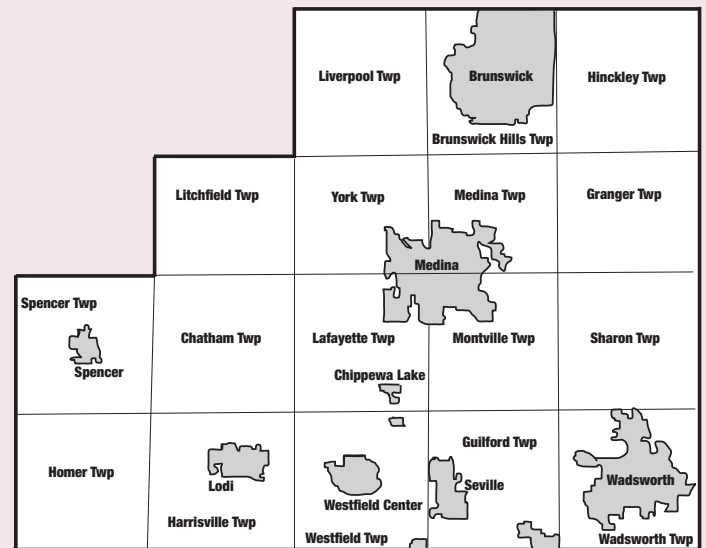
Readership:
